- 8. Case Studies - Becoming aware of youth vulnerabilities:** Examining the spectrum of youth vulnerability through six unique case scenarios.
- 9. Reporting, Closure and Redefinition:** This module wraps up the course by shedding light on how to close and redefine the mentor-mentee and mentor-organization relationships.

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
