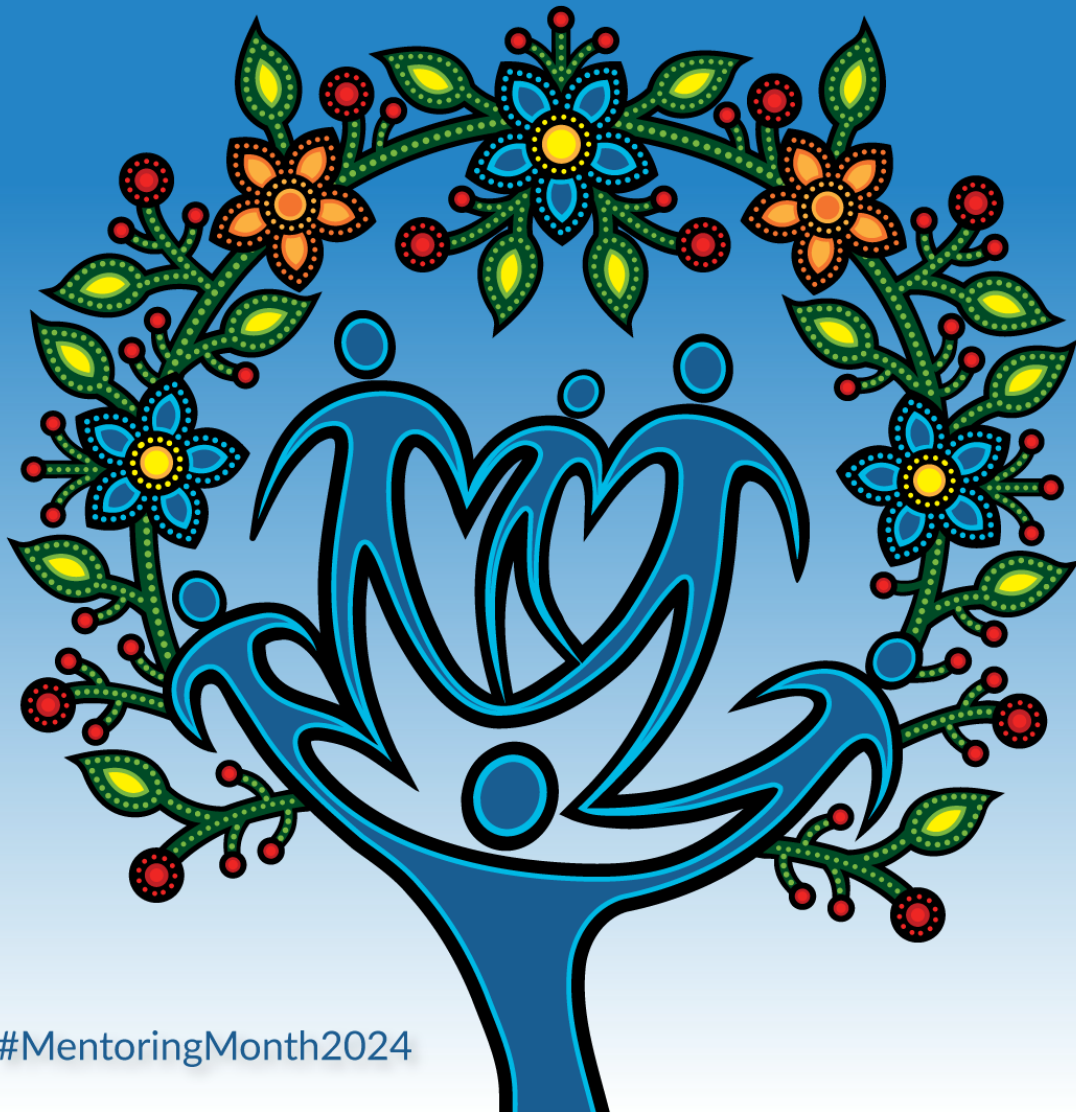

More than 800 kids are waiting to be paired with someone they can spend time with and look up to. Watch this CTV News clip that highlights Abdallah & Adam's match story.

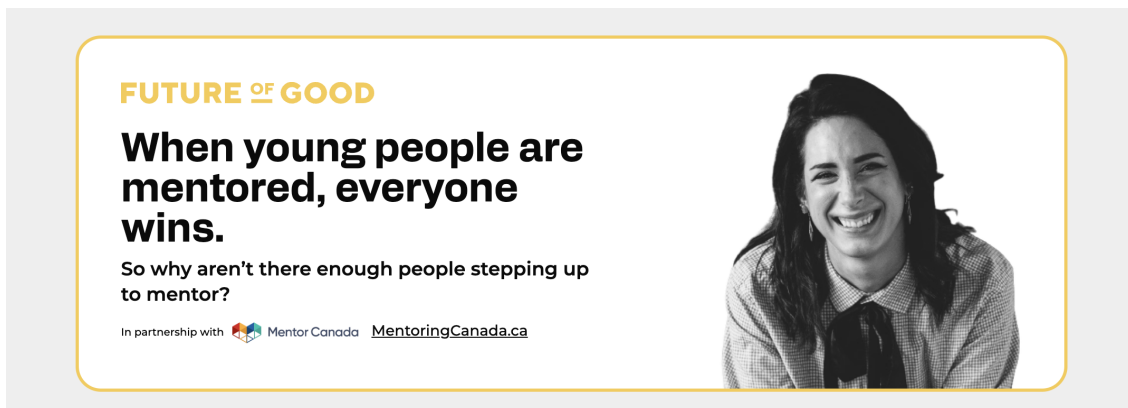
What is the Mentoring Gap?

January 23, 2024, 3:00PM MST

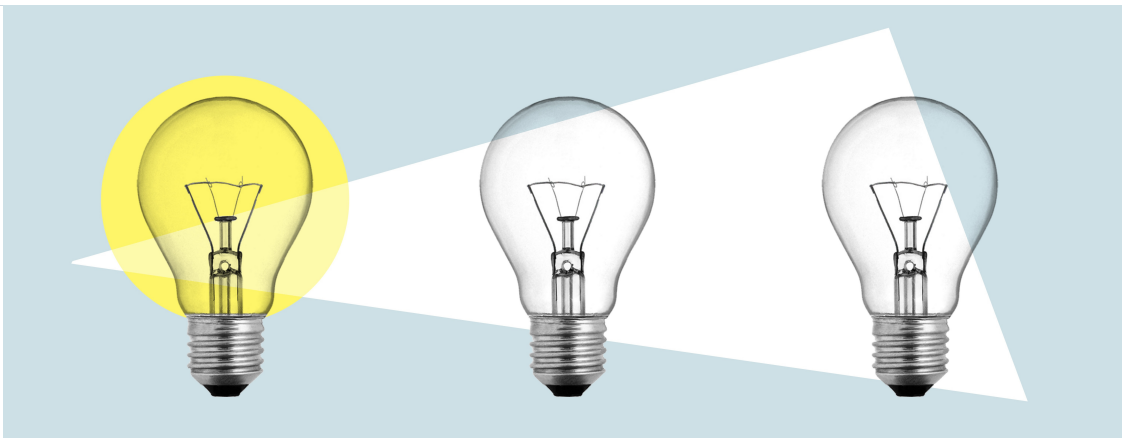
